**FATHER WHO FAILED TO PAY CHILD SUPPORT
SENTENCED TO 90 DAYS IN JAIL**

Monterey County District Attorney Dean D. Flipppo announced that on September 17, 2010, Henry B. Reed, Jr., 51 and a resident of Marina, was sentenced to serve 90 days in Monterey County jail for violating probation. His probation terms require him to pay child support, seek and maintain employment and report his job search efforts to the Department of Child Support Services.

Mr. Reed was previously convicted of failing to support his children and was placed on probation. He has also sustained a previous probation violation. In this case, he again failed to pay support and failed to report to Child Support Services as ordered.

An alert child support officer recently saw Mr. Reed working as a truck driver and used a cell phone camera to snap a picture. Mr. Reed was not paying any child support and had failed to report his truck driving job as ordered by the court. Mr. Reed owes over \$200,000 in past due child support and interest in three different California counties.

Judge Efren N. Iglesia had Mr. Reed immediately taken into custody to begin serving 90 days in jail, denying all work alternative and home confinement programs. Upon Mr. Reed's release, he must report to Child Support Services, provide for his children and begin complying with probation. Otherwise he may face further violation proceedings.
